Here's what the data says:

- Only 2.6% of senior employees in financial services are Black.¹
- The **lack of diversity** in the financial services industry might deter some Black Americans from looking at buying life insurance for the first time or adding to their existing coverage.²
- Black Americans report a higher level of financial concern than the overall U.S. population. The prevalence of these concerns, coupled with the disproportionate impact of COVID-19 on Black Americans, is influencing their likelihood to buy life insurance in the next year.³
